LAKEWOOD HOME OWNERS ASSOCIATIONLAKE RULES

- 1. A current Sport Pass is required to use any Community Properties.
- 2. Statues of the State of Texas Parks and Wildlife may be enforceable.
- 3. Please be advised to follow Texas Parks and Wildlife Manager's Requests.
- 4. Lakewood is a "no wake" recreation area.
- 5. Boats must leave no wake, they shall not exceed 5 mph and all motors shall not exceed 10 hp.
- 6. No person shall block the boat ramp by leaving their vehicle and for trailer on the ramp while fishing or boating.
- 7. All persons fishing or picnicking on another person's lot are subject to criminal trespass.
- 8. Trash receptacles will be provided for community properties.
- 9. No trotlines or similar rigs are allowed in Lakewood's waters.
- 10. Any person building a pier or dock from his lot must submit plans for approval by H.O.A. Board.

ADDITIONAL GROUNDS AND LAKE RULES

- 1. Sports Pass Holders should accompany their guest.
- 2. Sport Pass holders are limited to five adult (18 years or older) guests.
- 3. All persons misusing these facilities will be subject to criminal prosecution.
- 4. All park and lake facilities are closed at dark, (1/2 hour from sunset.)
- 5. Absolutely no overnight camping is allowed.
- 6. All motorized vehicles are to be parked in designated parking areas
- 7. All pets must be leashed or confined in Lakewood H.O.A. and park areas.
- 8. Please put all trash in trash cans.
- 9. Swim at own risk.
